

The following Ordinances & Resolutions were passed in February:

Ordinance 2018-02 – amends certain Sections of Chapter 184 “Earned Income Tax Effective January 1, 2016,” of the Codified Ordinances, to make the Village’s tax code conform with requirements and provisions that were amended in Chapter 718 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Ordinance 2018-03 – amends Sections 1151.07, “Setback Requirements,” and 1123.03, “Definitions,” of the Planning and Zoning Code to eliminate side setback requirement for corner lots and to apply the standard side setback requirements to corner lots. The current side setbacks applied to corner lots often reduce the amount of buildable area, making corner lots more difficult to develop. **Placed on First Reading and Referred to the Planning Commission**

Ordinance 2018-04 – designates Sherri Arrietta, Council Clerk to attend Sunshine Law Training sessions on behalf of elected officials.

Ordinance 2018-05 – approves and adopts the current replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances.

Resolution 2018-06 – approves the adoption of the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan

Ordinance 2018-07 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc., which includes general liability, police professional, public official, automobile, and property & cyber liability insurance at a total cost of \$57,193.00 per year.

Ordinance 2018-08 – authorizes the Mayor to purchase up-fitting equipment for two International truck cabs and chassis from Concord Road Equipment Mfg., Inc., through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Agreement.

Ordinance 2018-09 – authorizes all actions necessary to accept Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) Energized Community Grant(s).

Ordinance 2018-10 – enacts new Section 521.15, “Nuisances in Connection with Trees,” of the General Offenses Code and amending Section 1173.05 and Chapter 1353, both titled “Cutting of Trees” of the Codified Ordinances, to provide an enforcement mechanism for the Village to require the removal of dead or diseased trees, and to reduce the trunk diameter of the three (3) trees that can be remove without a permit, from twenty-four (24) inches in diameter at breast height to eight (8) inches diameter at breast height. **Placed on First Reading and Referred to the Planning Commission**

Ordinance 2018-11 – an appropriations ordinance which is a monthly financial housekeeping item.
