

The following Ordinances & Resolutions were passed in May:

**Ordinance 2018-10 (as amended)** – enacts new Section 521.15, “Nuisances in Connection with Trees,” of the General Offenses Code and amending Section 1173.05 and Chapter 1353, both titled “Cutting of Trees” of the Codified Ordinances, to provide an enforcement mechanism for the Village to require the removal of dead or diseased trees, and to reduce the trunk diameter of the four (4) trees that can be removed without a permit, from twenty-four (24) inches in diameter at breast height to eight (8) inches diameter at breast height. **Passed as amended**

**Ordinance 2018-15** – provides for the submission to the electors of the Village of Moreland Hills of a proposed amendment to Article IX, Section 4 of the Charter of the Village of Moreland Hills. This will increase the 3.0 mill levy by 3 mills for a total of 6 mills to pay the current and capital expenses associated with the Village Safety Service now and in the future. **Placed on Second Reading**

**Resolution 2018-19** – authorizes the Village to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for financial assistance to repair the “House on the Hill” on Forest Ridge property, under the State of Ohio NatureWorks Grant Program.

**Ordinance 2018-20** – authorizes participation by the Village in the Ohio Department of Transportation Winter Contract for road salt, for 2019.

**Ordinance 2018-21** - an appropriations ordinance which is a monthly financial housekeeping item.
