

The following Ordinances & Resolutions were passed in October:

Ordinance 2017-40 – amends Section 1177.11(g), “Solar Energy Systems,” of the Planning and Zoning Code as requested by the Fire Marshal, to include pathways on rooftops with solar panels and markings to ensure safe access and notice to fire department personnel in the case of a fire or other emergency at a structure with a solar energy system. **Placed on Second Reading**

Ordinance 2017-49 – amends Section 1131.13, “Decision of the Board of Appeals,” of the Codified Ordinances to make the expiration of BZA approvals consistent with the expiration of Planning Commission approvals. **Placed on First Reading and Referred to Planning Commission**

Ordinance 2017-50 – amends Section 931.04(a), “Sewerage Rates” of the Streets, Utilities, Public Services and Engineering Code to set a sewer service charge for Cru Uncorked.

Ordinance 2017-51 – an emergency ordinance requesting cooperation between the Village and the County for the bridge box beam replacement of the Chagrin River Road Bridge over Wiley Creek. This work will be completed and paid for by the county.

Resolution 2017-52- authorizes the Mayor to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for a potential grant for the funding of capital infrastructure improvement projects in the Village. This is specific to the slide on South Woodland.

Ordinance 2017-53 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Medical Mutual for the provision of health care insurance to Village employees, at the total estimated monthly cost of \$38,579.76.

Ordinance 2017-54 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Metlife for the provision of dental coverage to Village employees.

Ordinance 2017-55 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Guardian Life Insurance Company of America for the provision of life insurance to Village employees.

Ordinance 2017-56 – amends Section 951.02 and enacts new Section 951.04 of the Chapter “Solid Waste Collections and Disposal,” of the Codified Ordinances to reduce the number of special service pick-ups, and to add provisions regarding missed pick-ups, pick-ups for residents with special needs, and the disposal of materials from construction projects due to a tenant vacating a property. **Tabled and referred to the Roads and Safety Committee.**

Ordinance 2017-57 - an appropriations ordinance which is a monthly financial housekeeping item.
