

The following Ordinances & Resolutions were passed in September:

Ordinance 2017-40 – amends Section 1177.11(g), “Solar Energy Systems,” of the Planning and Zoning Code as requested by the Fire Marshal, to include pathways on rooftops with solar panels and markings to ensure safe access and notice to fire department personnel in the case of a fire or other emergency at a structure with a solar energy system. **Placed on Second Reading**

Ordinance 2017-44 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with SME for geotechnical work on State Route 87 to analyze the slope failure to determine the best method of stabilizing the slope, in the amount of \$29,100.

Ordinance 2017-45 – authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement between the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court and the Village of Moreland Hills for the continued participation in the Juvenile Court Community Diversion Program for 2018-2019.

Resolution 2017-46 – requests the County Fiscal Officer to make advances from the proceeds of real and personal property tax levies and special assessments during the Fiscal year 2018. Ohio Revised Code Section 321.34 provides that any money in the County treasury for the account of the Village and lawfully applicable to the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018.

Resolution 2017-47- accepts the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the county fiscal officer.

Ordinance 2017-48 - an appropriations ordinance which is a monthly financial housekeeping item.
